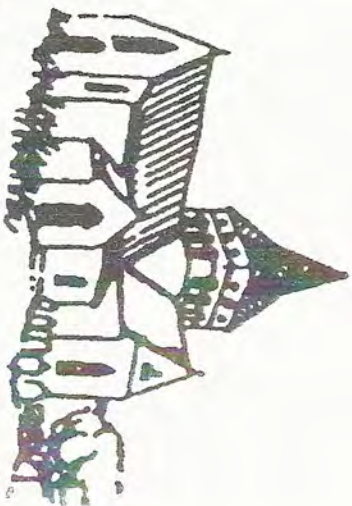






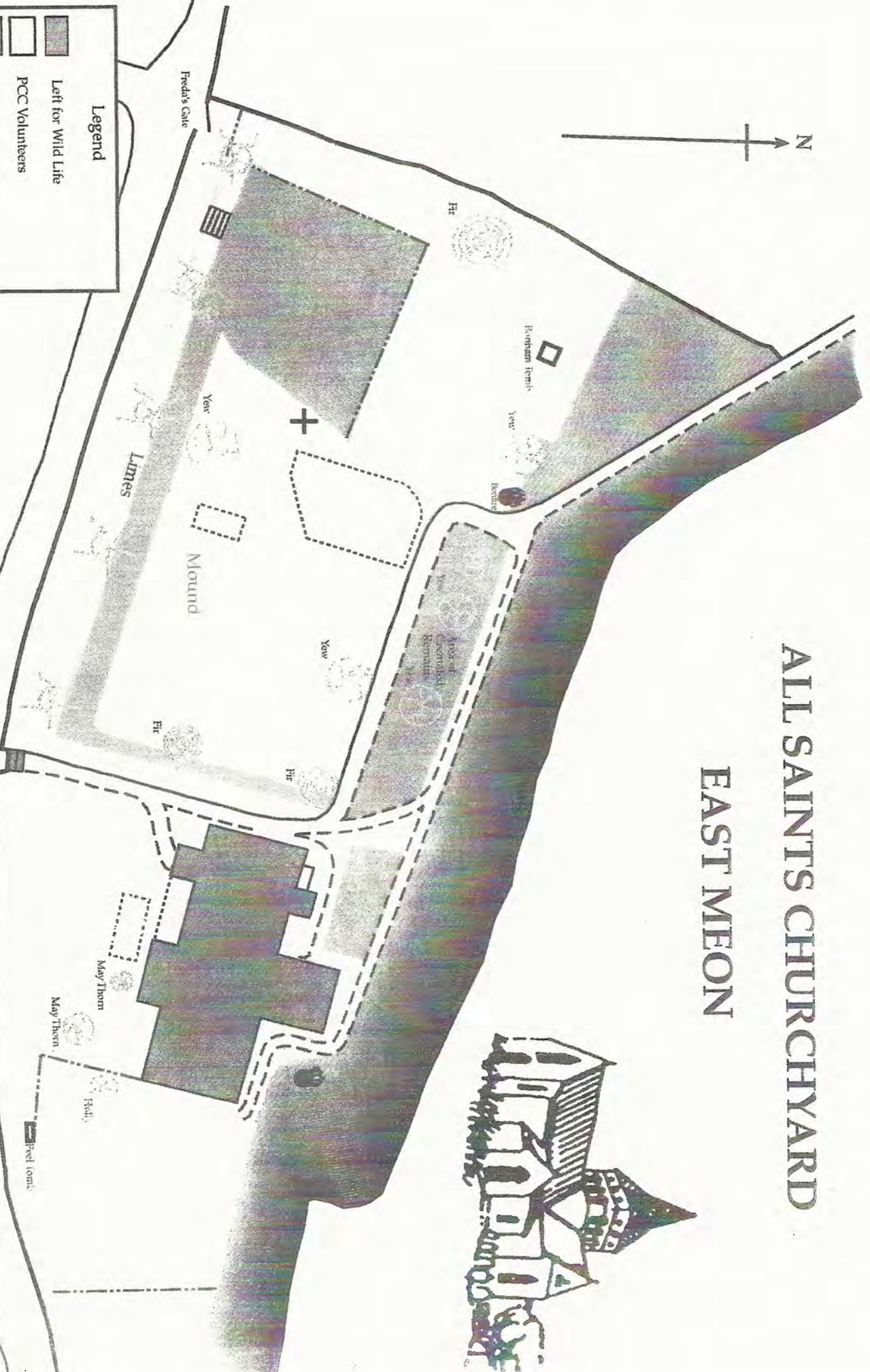


ALL SAINTS CHURCHYARD EAST MEON
