



EAST MEON - WESTERN END OF HIGH STREET 1922

The cows belonged to a David Coles who had a farm yard and retail shop, on the left, before the large Glenthorne House. The cows grazed in a field behind the trees on the right. There is now a housing estate here, called Glenthorne Meadow.

The river flooded most years, flooding houses and privies and causing great nuisance. After a great deal of pressure from the Parish Council the river was eventually deepened, straightened and concrete lined, and the bridges made higher and wider and 1954.

The War Memorial was erected in 1922.
