200+ "parfaits" (scholars) slain to death
Knights & families allowed truce.
Knights hid & parfaits who escaped in 16th with
the Cathars quietly because (in Toulouse)

Hughes Hughes de Payen + 8 Knights - keep the roads & highways safe... with especial regard to the protection of pilgrims.

Quartered off in a wing ^{of royal palace} built on the foundations of the ancient Temple of Solomon. (1118) returned 9 yrs later 1127 / 1128 Church Council convened at Troyes - Saint Bernard - Count of the Count of Champagne (Hughes de Payen (legis lord)).

- 1305 engineered the death of two Popes (Boniface VIII + Benedict XI) to get his own man in, Pope Clement V ex Arch Bishop of Bordeaux.

Down Friday Oct 13th 1307 all Templars in France seized - arrested.
all their preceptories placed under royal sequestration & their goods confiscated. However the order's immense wealth eluded him.

Treasure & docs smuggled by night ^{in wagons} to the order's naval base at La Rochelle - loaded into 18 galleys - disappeared.

1252 Henry III Tried to threaten the Templars

"You Templars -- have ~~take~~ so many liberties and
charters that your enormous possessions make you sail
with pride and haughtiness. What was impudently given
must therefore be prudently revoked; and what was
inconsiderately bestowed must be considerably recalled."

The Master of the Order replied: 'What sayest thou, O King?
Fare be it that thy mouth should utter so disagreeable
and silly a word. So long as thou doest exercise
justice, thou wilt reign. But if thou infringe it, thou
wilt cease to be King.' (Daroul, History of Secret Societies)

Court House E Meon 14th cent - King John? (Ass)

de Port - Warrford - stone hall-house.

1232 house of canons of the order of Premonstratensians founded in
Titchfield - white canons to distinguish them from
black canons of the order of St. Augustine.

1070-98 Wulfstan first Norman Bishop of Winchester, friend of William Rufus
pulled down Old Minster built new Cathedral. Also built
himself a palace at East Meon.

107-29 William Giffard Bishop of W - Chancellor of England.

1129-71 Henry de Blois (Bishop of W - Abbot of Glastonbury) elected Archbishop
of Canterbury 1136 but enemies in Rome prevented him from arriving.
Instead became Papal legate in England with precedence over Archbishop of Cant.

Henry II 1154 - went into exile for 3 years - came back supported
by Pope.

Petersfield manorial borough belonging to William Earl of Gloucester but gained Merchant Guild in Henry II's reign.

Portsmouth first charter granted by Richard I 1194 + in 1256 Gild Merchant (right to have) [modeled on Winchester]

Witchfield - Black Death Plague 1348-49 1361-62 1369 1379

Stephen became King in 1135 - Henry de Bois his younger brother
Pope Innocent II 1137 confirmed to the Bish of Win^{ter} the manors of
Meones & Weregrave

Confirmatory charters granted by next 3 Kings Henry II Richard I & John

1230 Lady chapel & south aisle added & a little later - spire⁽¹²⁴⁰⁾

King John 1199-1216 married in E. Meon? except in the Court House? Palace.

1305 Archbish visit overnight stay in Court Hse. - On Roasted

Virgate - approx 4 hide 30 acres but variable.

Assart - a forest clearing or enclosure.

Coffer - wooden chest storing valuables.

Nuncupative will - oral will

Temples -
- Waverford Mill (given by de Port before 1177?)
- Selbourne (Priory) (Preceptory) Founded by Bishop Peter des Roches 1230.
- North Baddesley Preceptory. foundation charter 1233
- God'sfield, Alresford. August Black Canons.

- 1114 Two powerful counts including Hugh de Payen, ^{of his large land} Count of Champagne
 1114 letter from the Bishop of Chartres to C of Champ referring to order of a Temple.
 1115 C of Champ donated land on which Saint Bernard (patron saint of Templars) built the Abbey of Clairvaux. One of the 9 founding knights Andrieu de Montbard was St Bernard's uncle. (Cistercian Order)

Order started in 1118? (Guillaume of Tyre)?

Count of Anjou joined order in 1120 2 years after foundation (?)

Count of Champagne joined in 1124

Bishop of Chartres died 1115

1128 Templars officially incorporated Council of Troyes.

Stables of Solomon (Temple).

1104 count of champ met with high ranking nobles at least one of who had just returned from Holy Land (Arbois de Subainville - Histoire de Champagne)

- (85) Shortly after count of champ went to H. land where he remained for 4 years returning in 1108. 1114 he went out again to join 'milice du Christ' but changed his mind returning a year later 1115

Following his return the Cistercians and the Templars became ~~so~~ immensely wealthy.

To the south of Jerusalem looms the 'high hill' of Mount Zion
 1099 Jerusalem fell to Godfrey de Bouillon's crusaders

(*Millière, Histoire d'Oval)

1070 group of monks arrive in Ardennes from Calabria (Godfrey de B. domain)
 Set up abbey at Oval on land donated by Duchess of Lorraine, Godfrey's aunt.

1108 Mysteriously disappeared

1095 Peter the Hermit (one of the monks) preached for crusade.

Godfrey's personal tutor (Jeanin, Les Chroniques)

1099 Monks accompanying Godfrey on crusade and install themselves in the abbey Mount Zion. Installed Godfrey King.

(William of Tyre, History of Deeds Done Beyond Sea)

1131 St Bernard is given Abbey at Orval.

Teana de Gisor born 1133 d 1220 ^{Grand} Master
of the Order de Lion ~~1188~~ and shortly after
became Prieur de Lion

Jean de Gisor 1188 - 1220

Marie de Saint Clair 1220 - 1266 ^{1st} Grand Master

Guillaume de Gisor 1266 - 1307

Edouard de Bar 1307 - 1336

^{1st} Grand Master
1187 - 1220
+ 1220 - 1307

Teana de Gisor Lord of Gisors, Normandy. Until
1193 a vassal of the King of England. Also owned
property in Sussex and the manor of Titchfield
(Lloyd, Origins of Anglo-Norman Families / Powicke, Lord
of Normandy)

He met Thomas a Becket at Gisors. 1169
(Roger de Hoveden - Annals)

When arresting officers, accompanied by the King himself
took the last Templar in 1307, they found neither money
nor documents. The treasurer was Hugues de Perard &
under him Gérard de Villes, the preceptor of France.

Gérard de Villes had pre warning - fled Temple with
30 knights - gone to sea in 18 galleys. Hugues de ~~Châlons~~
Châlons left with all the treasure of Hugues de Perard
- cum toto thesauro fratris Hugonis de Perardo (Finke, Papsttum und
Untergang des Templerordens)

A few days later Villes & Châlons were caught (Barber M. Trial
of the Templars)
