00.00 **Leal Wyatt**. Riverside, Father moves from West Meon, Morley Horder wanted a butcher's shop. The shop and slaughterhouse.

05.03 Leal born 1938, school, East Meon National School, Rowlands Castle

11.05 Went to Barnsley Workshop, cycled from East Meon, probation and apprenticeship

21.42 Met Lorna at dancing classes in Petersfield, married 1957, worked at Westbury for Jane Manners

27.25 Left Barnsley Workshop after a row with Edward Barnsley, joined Faulkners of Waterlooville

36.00 **Janet Fairbanks** Married to Will Fairbanks in 1956, 'Bill the Baker'. Father died at Stroud, knocked off motor bike. Met Wyatts through Dorothy Richards

Second tape of Janet Fairbanks

00.00 Janet part of Aburrow family. Wheelwright shop in village and wood mill at Drayton. Field where Vicarage now is, sold by Alfred Aburrow, Sale of field for Vicarage. Laurie Smith

Third tape, Leal and Janet

Shoe shop, George Barrow, Old Bell Inn, other shops and trades, Cyril Coles and Mrs Manning wrote as Manning-Coles, Cyril Cole as Francis Gate (Gaitehouse). Aburrow a Huguenot name. Jack Aburrow lived in Wheelwright, Freda's Gate, Norgate, her father.

Fourth tape Leal and Janet

Jasper Steer had factory for making chicken cages in yard of Glenthorne, later Goddard's Garage. Lambert family. Westbury is in East Meon, not West. Canadian soldiers in Westbury Park.
